We’ll continue into Washington, taking in the awesome beauty of Mount St Helen’s and Mount Rainier before arriving at the Rally. All in all, by the time we roll in to the rally site we will have covered more than 1,300 miles of America’s most amazing landscape!

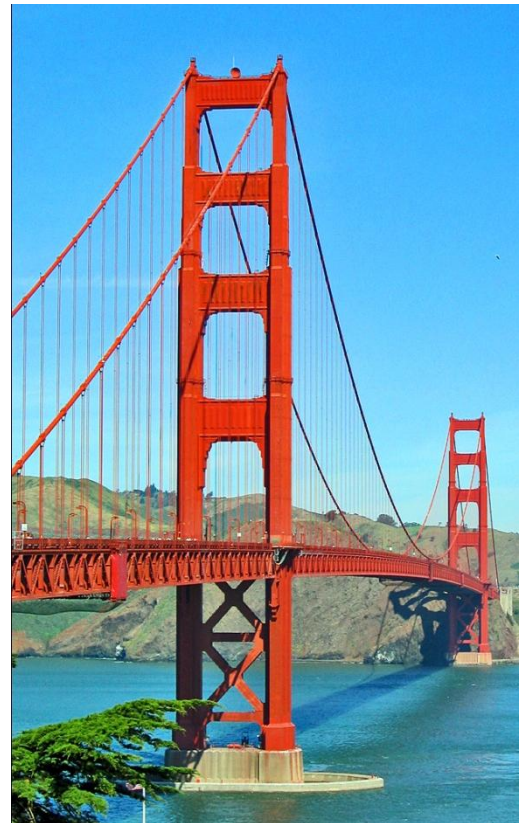
The Itinerary

Everyone will be responsible for carrying their own food, camping gear, maintenance equipment, fuel, \$\$\$ for incidentals, etc. We will provide a tour leader, with maps, GPS routes, and waypoints with meeting times.
